

**Communications and Conference Internship**

The Communications Internship is a part-time (30 hours/week) summer internship for students with an interest in Climate Communications, Conference Organizing and Management, and Writing or Video media development. Students will engage in media research, online communications, and article writing for CSCS’ website. The Communications Internship is based in Harrisonburg, VA, and includes housing stipend and an hourly wage for 30 hours per week.

<b>Qualifications:</b>	Preference to a student finishing their Sophomore or Junior year, studying Communications, Environmental Studies, Sustainability, Writing, or a similar program. Good communication skills, shared values with the Mennonite Church or other Anabaptist denominations, and a passion for climate issues all required.
<b>Responsibilities :</b>	<p>Conference Organizing and Management – 50% The intern will help to organize the Sustainability Summit, held at Eastern Mennonite University, August 5-7. Tasks include program and logistical planning in advance of the conference, and managing details during the conference.</p> <p>Social Media Development - 30% The intern will assist in expanding the Center’s presence on social media networks, including networking, profile creation and regular posting.</p> <p>Content Development - 40% The intern will create regular content based on their skill set, which the Center can use in advertising or promotion. Possible tasks include writing articles, creating resources, taking promotional pictures, or creating videos.</p> <p>Research/Analysis - 10% The intern will assist the Program Assistant in analyzing online presence and researching optimal communications strategies for the Center.</p> <p>Campaign Creation - 20%</p>
