

Climate Videography Internship

The Climate Videography Internship is a part-time (30 hours/week) summer internship for students with an interest in Filming, Video production, and Climate Communications. Students will engage in production of short videos to accompany a climate curriculum focused on church audiences. The Climate Videography Internship is remote-based and is paid an hourly wage for 30 hours per week.

Term Length:	3 months
Qualifications:	Preference to a student finishing their Sophomore or Junior year, studying Communications, Environmental Studies, Sustainability, or a similar program. Good videography and communication skills, shared values with the Mennonite Church or other Anabaptist denominations, and a passion for climate issues all required.
Responsibilities :	<p>Recording video content – 40% The intern will work with the director of pastoral ecology to organize at least three trips to record video of writers and presenters for the CSCS climate curriculum. These are likely not to be interviews but presentations created by those being recorded. This will include travel to at least the Pacific Northwest, northern Indiana, and the East Coast.</p> <p>Editing video content - 30% Once the video is recorded the intern will edit it into segments of 5 – 10 minute teaching times. While not required, adding graphics and animation is a plus. While these will be for the curriculum, they will also be available publicly on the CSCS YouTube channel and social media.</p> <p>Other video content development - 15% As available, the intern will create other content from CSCS staff and volunteers to help tell the story of CSCS and religious engagement on climate change.</p> <p>Social media/promotion - 15% The intern will assist the Program Assistant in promoting the video content created on social media platforms.</p>
